- **Outdoor Ping Pong Table:**

- **Volunteers for Father's Day Breakfast:**

- **Busy Bee:**
A WCPS Busy Bee has been planned for Saturday 9th of September at 8am. Posters will be placed around school. There will be a footy game after the busy bee.
- **Grants:**
Pina and Giselle are busy working on various grants such as:
"Maker Project Stream B". This is a \$20k grant that would provide robotics for years 4, 5&6. The P&F are happy to match funds if the grant is won. Entry will go out today or tomorrow.
"Telstra Grant", which is a \$1,200. You can apply for a maximum of 5 grants. These grants would provide, soccer tops, accessories for Ozmo, a croquet set on wheels, sports equipment and playground equipment.
"Playground Grant", for \$20k. This grant was suggested to us by a Federal Member. We need to meet the criteria of "improving an open space". This grant closes September 28th. The funds if won will need to be used by 2018. The P&F will match the grant if won.
"Kitchen Kart". This kart is a mobile kitchen and can be moved from class to class. Parents and teachers can submit their entry online using the link in the newsletter.
